

I played this idea with a piece of paper, but to make it easier I have put everything into a table, I suppose I could have used the scorecard, will try that once I'm sure what I want to do with this.

This is a 1U 1D Flat progression, you always make three bets at each level before you decide what you will do next. Let me explain the codes

**Mode:** M1 = Bet Trigger, M2 = Opposite to the Trigger

**Bet 1, Bet 2 and Bet 3**, these are the three bets we make for each round.

**BW** would mean we placed a bet on Banker and it won, and if you saw **BL** means a bet was placed on Banker and it lost.

**Balance:** At the end of each round we check to balance to see if we have a new session high, if we do have a new session high we reset back to level 01, but we will stay in the same mode that we placed the last three bets with.

If we have a losing set of three bets and we were for example in M1 we would do two things change to M2 and go up 1 level.

If we have a winning set of three bets and we are for example in M1 we would first of all check to see if we are at a new session high, if we do not have a new session high we would drop down one level and place another three bets using M1 because that is the last mode we used, we are now in flat mode, meaning as long as we keep winning the majority of the three bets we do not go down at the end of the three bets. Of course if we lose this round then the next round will be 1 level up and we will change mode to the winning mode.
